Keys to Success Before the Xmas

Mr. Doron's Top 8 Checklist

1. Bring your workbook home and look online ([www.flowinsports.com/lshs](http://www.flowinsports.com/lshs) for good examples of exam questions. Solutions are provided so double check your work.
2. Go to Mr. Doron's tutorial which is on Tuesday December 17<sup>th</sup> from 9-11am. **Serious students only who want to succeed only.**
3. Make sure you are enrolled in the online course. More info at [www.flowinsports.com/lshs](http://www.flowinsports.com/lshs). Click the course that you are enrolled in (math 511-11 or math 511-14) and CAREFULLY follow the instructions. There is also a video that shows you a step-by-step procedure on how to enroll. Still stuck? Send me an email ([ldoron@swlauriersb.qc.ca](mailto:ldoron@swlauriersb.qc.ca)) and tell me where you are stuck and I'll walk you through it. **Deadline ASAP**
4. Do the online quiz on the oral presentation. It's 10 questions before **Tuesday December 17<sup>th</sup>**. Remember, you must complete #2 to do this. Once you've created the account, you can login from [elearning.flowinsports.com](http://elearning.flowinsports.com)
5. Write 50 potential exam questions. The 1<sup>st</sup> five questions should be from the exam. No need to write the entire question – just a brief summary of what you need to do and then show your work carefully. If you are stuck, there are videos that show you a step-by-step example of what your answers should look like and that can be seen when you click video solutions at [www.flowinsports.com/lshs](http://www.flowinsports.com/lshs)
6. Write down the two chapter of notes from learn Quebec. The two chapters you are responsible for are optimization and maps. This will help reinforce some of the material we did as well and bridge the gap between any things we missed in class. There are excellent videos that will help you fully understand the material. If you know the concept, no need to write it. **If you are unsure or it's new, write it down.** Try to understand what you are writing. 7. Bring your scientific calculator, eraser and at least two pencils to the exam which is on December 18<sup>th</sup> 2013 from 9-12. Show up at least 15 minutes in advance to reduce stress.
8. Work on your memory aid organized into two pages (one for each topic). Write down key-words in maps (often located in the boxes in your workbook) as well questions that are recommended from Mr. Doron's website. Recopy the "less than", "must not exceed" section in the stencil given to you as well as anything else you find useful. Bringing in a memory aid shows you've done some preparation. Please write your full name and date on this sheet.

Remember everything you do will count not only for points, bonus points and all those other goodies but will also maximize your chances in obtaining the highest mark possible. **I know this is a lot of work but trust me, the reward will be worth it at the end.** Good luck and enjoy!
